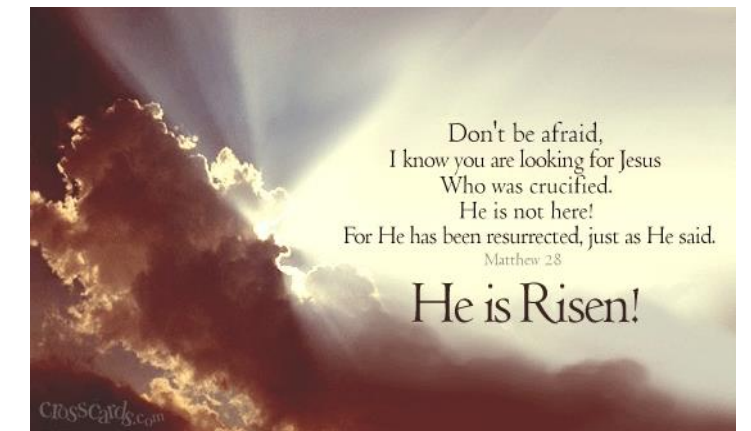
To start using FORMED simply follow these instructions:

Second Reading
Genesis 22:1-18, God puts Abraham to the test.

Responsorial Psalm: *Psalm 16:5,8-11*
The Lord shows us the path of life.

Third Reading: *Exodus 14:15—15:1*
The Israelites pass through the Red Sea.

Responsorial Psalm: *Exodus 15:1-6,17-18*
